9. Mareen DuVall, one of the earliest and most prominent of the Huguenot immigrants from France, arrived in the province of Maryland August 28, 1650. On the day of his arrival he received the patent of a tract of land on the south side of South River in Anne Arundel County, Maryland, near the site of New London.
